2020 STORM SEWER AND CATCH BASIN REPAIR PROGRAM

BRITTANY AVENUE – ASH AVENUE TO OAK AVENUE

NOVEMBER 2, 2020

The City of Eastpointe has awarded a contract to remove and replace defective storm sewer pipe and catch basins at certain locations throughout the City of Eastpointe. As part of this program, a storm sewer crossing located on Brittany Avenue south of Oak Avenue will be removed and replaced.

The Contractor expects to start removals on Wednesday, November 4. Therefore, Brittany Avenue will be closed to through traffic between Ash Avenue and Oak Avenue to complete this work. Residents within this section of Brittany Avenue will still have access to their homes, with the exception of the residents located at 22146 Brittany where pavement removals will take place. Residents at this location will be required to park their vehicles on the street during working hours outside of the construction limits to be painted with pink paint. The storm sewer work is expected to be completed by Thursday, November 5th and the road temporarily reopened to traffic until concrete replacement takes place. You will receive another notification when concrete replacement work and vegetative restoration work will take place. Garbage pickup, mail delivery and parcel delivery will not be interrupted at any time during this project.
